OVERVIEW

Famous for its incredible historical cities; delightful Uzbekistan is the land of the great Khanates and Sultanates – the kingdoms that controlled the Silk Road of Khiva, Bukhara and Samarkand.

Once home of the mighty warlord Timur, Samarkand's highlight is the great Registan Square, surrounded with grand madrasah. Bukhara perfectly captures the atmosphere of Central Asia before the Russian domination, and has many spectacular buildings such as the Kalon Mosque and the Ark Fortress. We will also be visiting Tashkent, the country's capital and the most modern Uzbeki city. The elaborately decorated metro stations of Tashkent are a sight to be seen, and outside of the cities Uzbekistan is just as full of surprises – like the traditional villages of the Nuratau Mountains, where we will be staying for a night to experience the lifestyle and customs of the Uzbeki and Tajiki people.

This is an experiential journey of Uzbekistan in all its charming glory.

Day 1 : May 10

TASHKENT ARRIVAL - CITY TOUR

Welcome to the eclectic capital of Uzbekistan where modern skyscrapers mix with Soviet-era architecture and mosaic mausoleums. The largest city in Central Asia, Tashkent is a mix of Russian and Uzbek styles, an indication of the fact that for many years it was a key city of the USSR.

Arrive and transfer to the hotel. **Check in time is 2 p.m.**

Afternoon , we set out to explore Tashkent. You can visit the **Amir Temur square, Chorsu Bazaar, Holy Assumption Russian Orthodox Church and Independence Square.**

Later you can take a metro train ride to see some of Tashkent's beautiful subway stations and try some Uzbeki kebabs and pilaf for dinner.

Day 2 : May 11

**TASHKENT - SAMARKAND
(310 KMS) HIGH SPEED TRAIN**

After breakfast, we take one of Uzbekistan's **high speed train to the ancient Silk Road hub of Samarkand.**

The city has long been a center of artisans and traders as well as the prize for many a conquering army, leaving behind a rich and complex history.

Check into the hotel and after lunch walk around town and free to explore Samarkand.

Day 3 : May 12

SAMARKAND GUIDED CITY TOUR

Explore the magnificent Silk Road city of Samarkand on a **full-day guided tour** through its most iconic monuments and vibrant local markets. The day begins at the legendary **Registan, the heart of the ancient city**, surrounded by three grand madrasahs adorned with intricate turquoise tiles and geometric patterns.

Continue to the majestic **Bibi-Khanym Mosque**, once one of the largest mosques in the Islamic world and built by Timur to honor his favorite wife. A short walk leads to the bustling **Siab Bazaar**, where locals trade fresh fruits, spices, nuts, and traditional Samarkand bread.

After lunch, visit the spectacular **Shah-i-Zinda necropolis**, a stunning avenue of mausoleums decorated with some of the finest tilework in Central Asia. The tour concludes at the elegant **Gur-e-Amir Mausoleum, the resting place of the great conqueror Timur**.

Day 4 : May 13

**SAMARKAND - NURATAU
180 KMS (3.5 HRS)**

After breakfast, we drive out to a mountain village in the **Nuratau mountains** crossing Nurata town.

The mountains overlooking the **Adyar lake** is one of the highlights of the tour where you stay in a Tajik village and experience the life of the mountain people.

Late afternoon for a **light trek in the village and the hill trails** around it or just explore the oasis of cherry, almond, apricot, apple and berry trees in the village. The mountains are also home to the rare Severtsov's Argali, a wild sheep species that inhabits the rocky slopes of the region, which we can witness on the trek.

Later **traditional Uzbeki home cooked dinner** with the family.

Overnight at Nuratau Mountain Village Homestay.



Day 5 : May 14

**NURATAU - GIJDUYON - BUKHARA
350 KMS (5.5 HRS)**

After breakfast travel to Bukhara, known as one of the most charming cities in the country.

Stop along the way in **Gijduvan**, famous for its ceramic pottery, where you'll have the chance to visit a pottery workshop. Witness the pottery process from start to finish and see a small museum to uncover the centuries-old history of ceramics in this area. Reach

Bukhara by late afternoon and later free to explore Bukhara.

Day 6 : May 15

BUKHARA GUIDED CITY TOUR

Today we go a **guided city tour of Bukhara.**

Visit the historic **Ark of Bukhara**, the former residence of the city's emirs, and the elegant Bolo Hauz Mosque.

Continue to the impressive **Po-i-Kalyan Complex**, home to the iconic **Kalyan Minaret, Kalyan Mosque, and Mir-i-Arab Madrasa**. Walk through Bukhara's traditional trading domes before arriving at the lively **Lyabi-Hauz Ensemble**, a charming square surrounded by historic madrasas and teahouses.

The tour concludes at the beautiful **Ismail Samani Mausoleum**, one of **Central Asia's oldest architectural masterpieces.**

Day 7 : May 16

BUKHARA - TASHKENT

470 KMS - HIGH SPEED TRAIN

After breakfast transfer to the railway station to take the **Afrosiyob train to Tashkent.**

Arrive in Tashkent by late afternoon.

Evening free to explore Tashkent and visit Khast Imom Complex including the Barak Khan madrassa (a college for Islamic instruction).

Overnight in Tashkent.



Day 8 : May 17
