Day 1 : July 4

**BALI ARRIVAL -
UBUD CITY WALK**

Welcome to the enchanting island of Bali where lush jungles blend with ancient temples and sun-kissed beaches. The cultural heart of Indonesia, Bali is a mix of tradition and natural beauty, an indication of the fact that for centuries it has been a spiritual and artistic haven.

Arrive and transfer to the hotel. **Check in time is 2 p.m.**

Evening free to explore Ubud market and town.

Day 2 : July 5

**UBUD - TANAH LOT - ULUWATU
FULL DAY TOUR**

After breakfast, visit **Monkey Forest, Saraswati Temple & Ubud Palace**. Later leave for a half-day tour visiting two of the most important temples in Bali, **Tanah Lot and Uluwatu Temple**. Tanah Lot temple is built on a huge rock about three acres in size and 20 meters into the sea and Uluwatu Temple sits on a 70-meter-high cliff protruding above the sea.

Lata afternoon, its time for a beautiful Balinese cultural experience witnessing the **Kecak Dance Performance**. Kecak is a traditional Balinese dance drama performance depicting a battle of the Ramayana and is primarily performed by men.

Day 3 : July 6

**TAGALALANG - KINTAMANI -
LAKE TEMPLE - MUNDUK**

After breakfast, head out to the highlands of central Bali. Our first stop on the way to the **Tagalalang rice terraces** that have been built into the sides of the mountains and follow the natural contours of the hills.

Next, we visit **Ulun Danu Beratan Temple**, on the way passing through **Kintamani and Mount Batur**. Not only is the temple in itself beautiful but its located in the most spectacular settings on the banks of Lake Beratan. The location of the temple at a lake surrounded by misty mountains makes it a serene and peaceful place to visit. On the way, there are a few Bali swings for the quintessential Bali photo.

Later, we visit the quaint and beautiful village of **Munduk** in the central highlands for an overnight stay.

Day 4 : July 7

**MUNDUK - BANJAR HOT SPRING
- LOVINA**

After breakfast, set out on a short walk through village paths and plantation trails to visit the serene **Munduk and Melanting Waterfalls**. Enjoy the refreshing cascades—perhaps even a quick shower beneath the falls.

Later head to **Air Panas Banjar** (Hot Spring), where you can relax and soak in the natural hot spring pools. By afternoon, arrive in Lovina, have lunch, and unwind at your hotel.

In the evening, watch the sunset from **Lovina Beach**.

Day 5 : July 8

**LOVINA - GIT GIT WATERFALLS -
AMED**

Today is a day to watch dolphins in the sea. Rise early in the morning for a **Dolphin watching tour** off the coast of Lovina. Take a boat ride into the sea and watch schools of dolphins swimming around. As soon as the sun starts to rise, and the orange color of the sky reflects on the sea, the dolphins appear. If you are lucky, they will sometimes swim, jump, and play just next to your boat.

Later, after breakfast, we drive along the beautiful coastal road to **Amed**. On the way, stop at the beautiful **Git Git waterfalls**. See the black sand and the white sand beaches of Amed and go snorkeling at **Jemuluk Bay**

Later in the evening watch one of the **best sunsets in Bali**.

Day 6 : July 9

**AMED - GATES OF HEAVEN -
TIRTHA GANGA - VIRGIN BEACH**

After breakfast, we head **Pura Agung Lempuyang (Gates of Heaven)** for some iconic Bali photos with the majestic Mount Batur in the background and the quintessential Gates of Heaven Instagram photo.

Later visit **Tirtha Ganga** and later stop at the little-known but beautiful **Virgin Beach** at Karangasem.

After lunch, we head to Kuta and reach by late afternoon. Evening explore Kuta area and market on walks.

Day 7 : July 10

**KUTA - SEMINYAK
FREE DAY**

Today is a free day to explore and enjoy some of the many activities available in South Bali.

Kuta is the hub of tourism in Bali with all the requisite shopping streets, malls, restaurants, cafes, massage parlors, and discos. Today is a free day to explore Kuta and Kuta beach. Kuta beach, a beautiful, long stretch of wide sandy beach, is the place that put Bali on the map, and a must-visit during your stay in the area. If it's retail therapy, massage, culinary experiences, or partying you're looking for, it's all there within walking distance.

You can also choose to do a day trip to Nusa Penida.
