OVERVIEW

This ultimate Indonesian adventure brings together two of Indonesia's most captivating island experiences —the rugged beauty of Komodo National Park and the relaxed coastal charm of Lombok.

The journey begins in Labuan Bajo, gateway to Komodo. Over a multi-day sailing experience, guests explore remote islands with dramatic landscapes and rich marine life. Highlights include Padar Island viewpoints, visits to Komodo and Rinca to see the legendary Komodo dragons, and swimming and snorkelling with Manta Rays.

The journey then continues to Lombok, offering a slower, more laid-back contrast. From the beaches of Kuta Lombok to the coastline of Senggigi, and north to Senaru's waterfalls beneath Mount Rinjani, the island blends natural beauty with authentic local life.

Day 1 : July 18

**LABUAN BAJO -
BEACH & TOWN WALK**

Arrive in Labuan Bajo, the gateway to the Komodo Islands.
Later transfer to the hotel.

Check in time is 2 p.m.

Evening free to explore the town and see the sunset from Pede beach. Later,
visit the night market near the harbour for dinner.

Day 2 : July 19

**CUNCA WULANG FALLS -
RANGKO CAVE - AMELIA HILL**

After breakfast, venture inland from Labuan Bajo to explore Flores' lush landscapes and limestone terrain. A short jungle trek leads to **Cunca Wulang Waterfall**, a dramatic canyon waterfall with clear pools set between high rock walls, ideal for a refreshing swim.

After lunch, continue to **Rangko Cave**, a hidden limestone cave opening into a calm, crystal-clear lagoon, where sunlight creates striking blue hues across the water.

On the way back, stop at **Amelia Sea View** for the best sunset views from Labuan Bajo, where you can see sweeping views of the surrounding islands and coastline.

Day 3 : July 20

**KOMODO SAILING -
KELOR - KALONG - PADAR ISLAND**

After breakfast, board your sailboat around 10 a.m. and begin your **unforgettable journey through Komodo National Park on a three-day sailing adventure.**

Your first stop is **Kelor Island**, where a short hike offers sweeping views over **rugged hills** and turquoise waters. Continue to **Manjarite** for a relaxed **snorkeling** session in calm, coral-rich waters before cruising towards **Kalong Island**.

As evening approaches, **witness thousands of flying foxes take to the skies at sunset—one of Komodo's most iconic sights**—before settling in for an overnight stay on the boat near Padar Island.

Day 4 : July 21

SAILING - DAY 2

**KOMODO ISLAND - PINK BEACH -
MANTA POINT - TAKA MAKASSAR**

Start early with a **sunrise hike on Padar Island**, known for its **dramatic viewpoints** overlooking crescent-shaped bays.

After breakfast, head to **Pink Beach** to relax and snorkel in vibrant waters before visiting either **Komodo Island** or **Rinca Island** for a **guided walk to see the legendary Komodo dragons** in their natural habitat.

The day continues with **snorkeling at Manta Point**, where you may encounter graceful manta rays, followed by a stop at the stunning **Taka Makassar sandbank** and an additional reef site, offering some of the best marine life in the region.

Overnight on board sailboat.



Day 5 : July 22

SAILING - DAY 3

SEBAYUR - LABUAN BAJO

Enjoy a relaxed morning with a final **snorkeling session at a nearby reef such as Sebayur or Kanawa**, where calm waters and healthy corals provide a perfect last glimpse of Komodo's underwater world. After breakfast on board, **cruise back to Labuan Bajo, arriving around 1 p.m.**

After lunch, relax and have an evening free to explore the town and harbour area/night market.

Day 1 : July 23

LOMBOK EXTENSION LABUAN BAJO - LOMBOK

Arrive at **Lombok International Airport** and transferred to **Senggigi (2-hour drive)**. The drive offers your first glimpses of Lombok's coastline and rural landscapes.

Check into the hotel and relax. **Check in time is 2 p.m.**

Senggigi is known for its laid-back vibe, making it a perfect starting point. The rest of the day is **free to explore Senggigi town**, or in the late afternoon, head to **Malimbu Hill for one of Lombok's best coastal sunsets**, with views stretching toward the Gili Islands.

Overnight in Senggigi.



Day 2 : July 24 - LOMBOK

SENGIGI - GILI AIR

After breakfast, transfer to Bangsal Harbor, followed by a **speedboat ride to Gili Air.**

Check into your beachside stay and spend the day enjoying the island's relaxed charm:

Many options to choose from – Snorkel directly from shore (often with turtles nearby), Walk around the island, Enjoy beachfront cafés and slow island living, go kayaking or paddle boating, Island hopping to Gili Trawangan. End your day with a classic sunset facing Bali's Mount Agung. Dinner by the beach.

Overnight in Gili Air.



Day 3 : July 25 - LOMBOK

GILI AIR - SENARU

Take an early morning boat back to Bangsal, then continue by road to Senaru (2.5 hrs)

On arrival, visit the region's most famous waterfalls: **Sendang Gile Waterfall** – a short walk from the entrance, and **Tiu Kelep Waterfall** – further ahead with a scenic jungle trail of about 45 minutes.

After the waterfalls tour, later check into your hotel in **Senaru** by evening. Enjoy cooler temperatures and, if the weather permits, views of Mount Rinjani.

Overnight in Senaru.



Day 4 : July 26 - LOMBOK

SENARU - KUTA LOMBOK

CROSS ISLAND DRIVE

After breakfast, depart for **Kuta Lombok**. A five-hour scenic journey through traditional villages, rice fields, and hilly landscapes gets you to Kuta Lombok on the south coast of Lombok, which has some of the most beautiful beaches on the island.

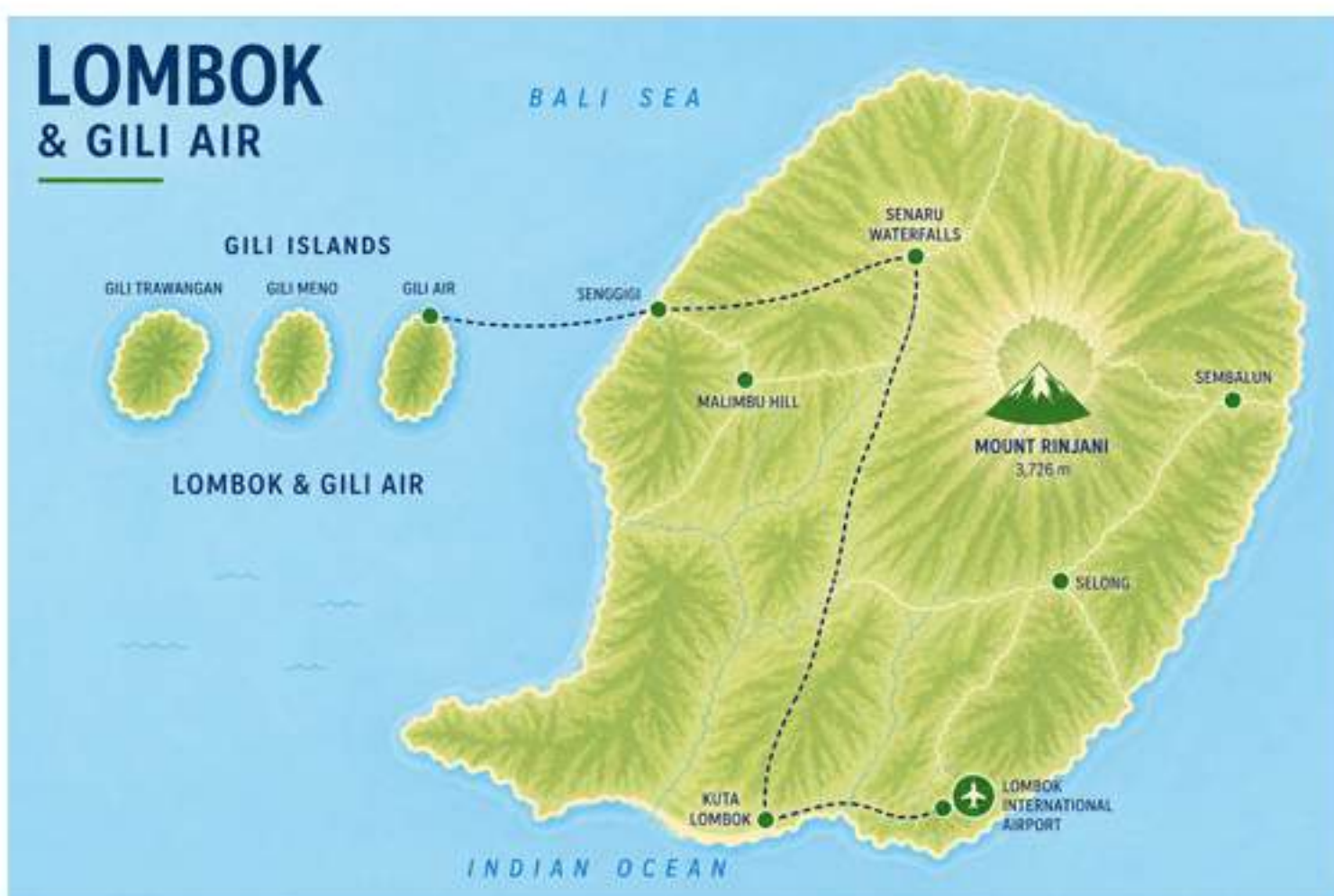
Visit **Tanjung Aan** – soft white sand and calm turquoise water, **Selong Belanak** – wide bay ideal for beginner surfing, **Mawun Beach** – quieter, crescent-shaped bay surrounded by hills. End your day with sunset on the beach, followed by dinner at one of Kuta's trendy cafés.

Overnight in Kuta, Lombok.

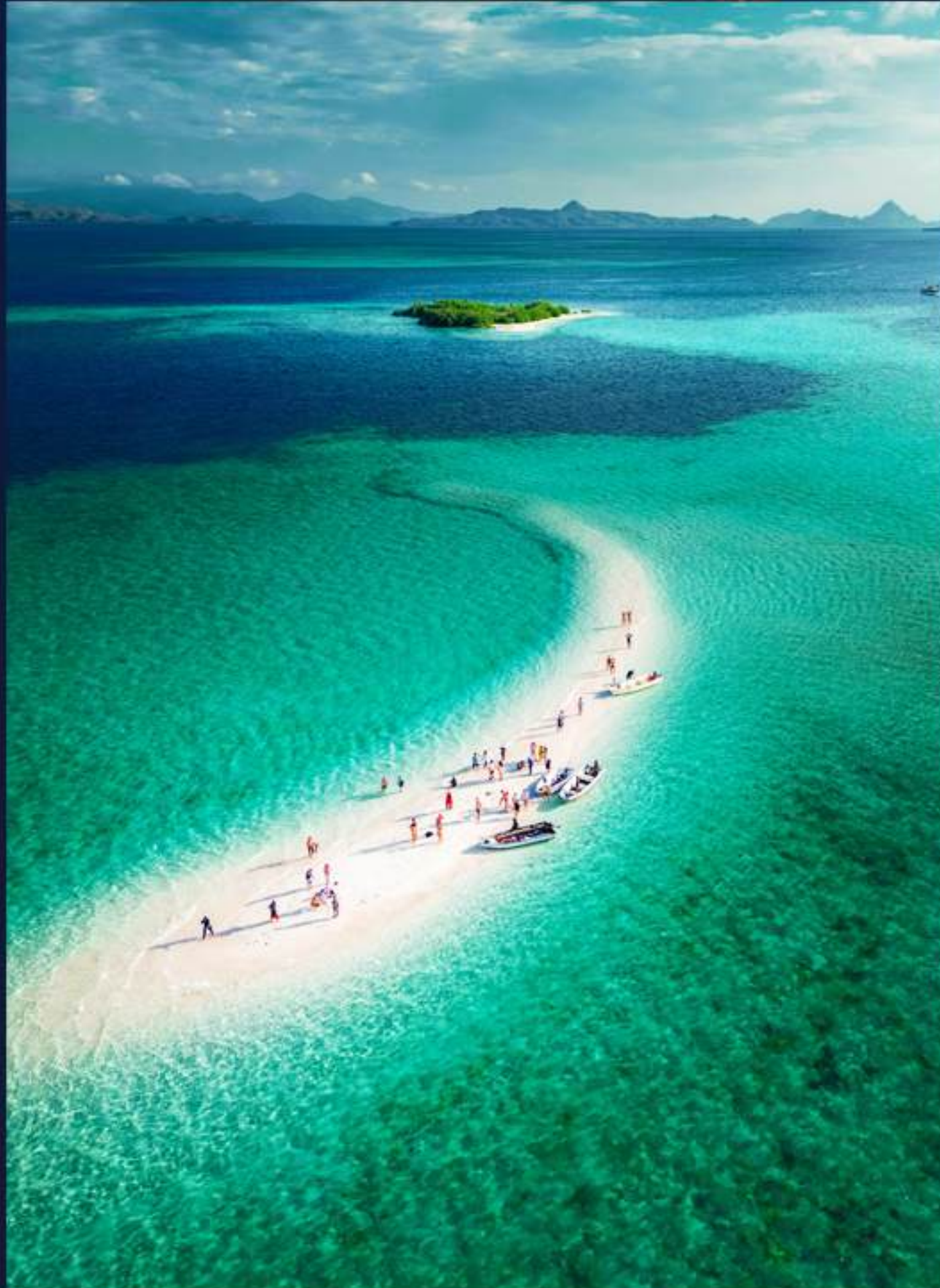
