Travel deep into the Konyak heartland to Longwa, a fascinating village straddling the India–Myanmar border, meet some of the last face-tattooed former headhunters, and stay in traditional village homestays.

This is an immersive and offbeat Nagaland journey for travelers seeking authentic experiences and deeper exploration, going far beyond the typical Hornbill Festival trip.

**Day 1 : Dec 5**

## **DIMAPUR ARRIVAL**

Arrive in Dimapur, the gateway to Nagaland and an important commercial hub of the state.

Arrive and transfer to the hotel. **Check in time is 2 p.m.**

Afternoon and evening free to explore Dimapur town and market area and if interested you could try some Naga dishes for dinner.

**Overnight in Dimapur.**



**Day 2 : Dec 6**

**DIMAPUR - KIGWEMA  
( 90 KMS / 3 HRS )**

After breakfast, drive to **Kigwema**, a picturesque **Angami village** and the gateway to the famous **Hornbill Festival**. En route, visit the **Kohima War Cemetery**, explore the local markets of **Kohima**, visit the museum and learn about the region's history and tribal heritage.

Arrive in Kigwema by late afternoon and settle into your homestay near the festival venue. Later, head to the Hornbill Festival grounds to enjoy the vibrant evening performances, music and cultural programs that bring together the many tribes of Nagaland.

**Day 3 : Dec 7**

## **HORNBILL FESTIVAL**

Today is dedicated to experiencing the **Hornbill Festival**, often called the “Festival of Festivals.” Held annually near Kohima, it brings together the diverse tribes of Nagaland in a vibrant celebration of culture and tradition.

Spend the day **exploring the festival grounds, watching colourful tribal performances, traditional dances, indigenous games, music concerts** and handicraft exhibitions. Sample local delicacies, interact with people from different tribes and immerse yourself in the unique cultural heritage of Nagaland.

**Day 4 : Dec 8**

## **KHONOMA EXCURSION - HORNBILL FESTIVAL**

Today, drive to **Khonoma**, a beautiful **Angami village** known as India's **first green village**. Surrounded by terraced fields and forested hills, Khonoma offers a fascinating glimpse into traditional Naga life and sustainable community practices.

Walk through the village lanes, admire the traditional architecture and learn about the history and culture of the Angami people. Later, return to Kigwema and **spend the afternoon and evening enjoying more of the Hornbill Festival's cultural performances, exhibitions and festivities.**

**Day 5 : Dec 9**

**KIGWEMA - MOKONCHUNG  
( 160 KMS / 6 HRS )**

After breakfast, leave the Kohima region and journey deeper into Nagaland towards **Mokokchung, the cultural heartland of the Ao Naga tribe**. The **scenic drive winds through rolling hills, forested landscapes and remote villages**, offering beautiful views of rural Nagaland.

Arrive in Mokokchung by afternoon and explore this **charming hill town, known for its rich traditions, welcoming people and vibrant tribal culture**. Spend the evening strolling through the town, visiting local markets and soaking in the relaxed atmosphere.

**Overnight in Mokokchung.**



**Day 6 : Dec 10**

**MOKOKCHUNG - LONGWA  
( 190 KMS / 7 HRS )**

After an early breakfast, visit the **scenic village of Longkhum**, perched high on a ridge and renowned for its breathtaking views of the surrounding valleys and hills. Rich in Ao Naga folklore and traditions, the village offers a fascinating insight into local culture and way of life.

Later, continue the journey eastward **towards Longwa in Mon district, home of the Konyak tribe**. One of Nagaland's most remote and intriguing villages, **Longwa sits along the India–Myanmar border** and is famous for its unique location and rich tribal heritage.

Arrive by late afternoon and settle into your **traditional Konyak homestay**.

**Day 7 : Dec 11**

## **LONGWA ( MYANMAR BORDER )**

Today is dedicated to **exploring Longwa, one of Nagaland's most fascinating villages and home to the legendary Konyak tribe.** Situated on the **India–Myanmar border,** the village offers a rare opportunity to experience a culture that remained largely isolated until recent decades.

**Visit the house of the Ang (village chief)** and meet and interact with the Ang and also **meet some of the last remaining tattooed Konyak headhunters,** whose facial tattoos and stories offer a remarkable glimpse into the region's past.

Later, enjoy a **traditional cultural performance by Konyak women,** featuring tribal songs, dances and customs that have been passed down through generations.

**Overnight in Longwa.**



**Day 8 : Dec 12**

**LONGWA - MON - DIBRUGARH  
( 185 KMS / 7 HRS )**

After breakfast start for the **journey to Dibrugarh.**

Reach by late afternoon and evening free to explore Dibrugarh town, market and the Brahmaputra Riverside..

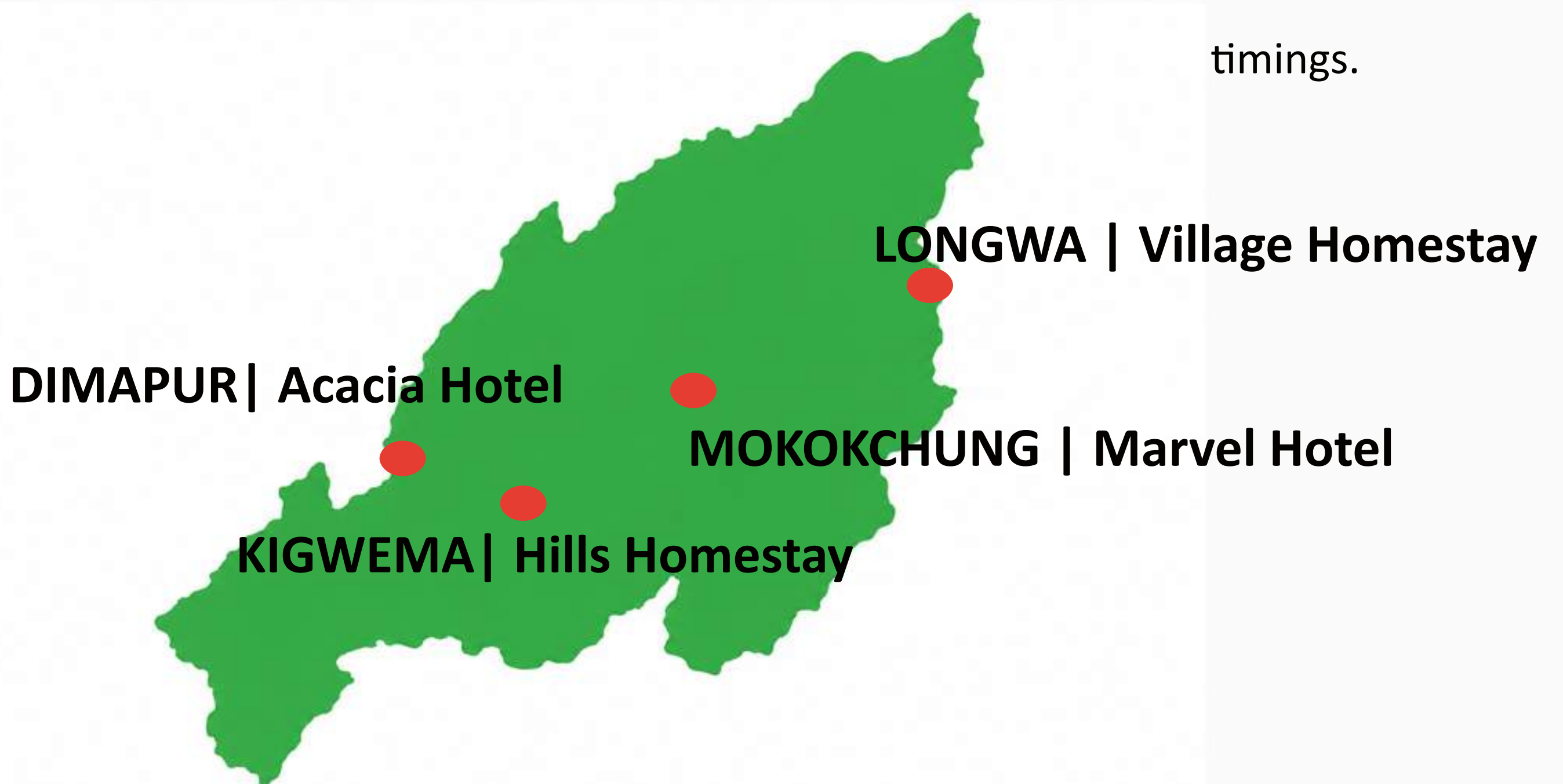
